

Controller's information about personal data processing

Fulfilling the obligation to provide information pursuant to Article 13(1) and (2) of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) [Official Journal of the EU L.2016.119.1 of 4 May 2016], hereinafter referred to as GDPR, we inform you that:

I. The Controllers of your personal data are

- a) The Controller of your personal data is the AGH University of Krakow, al. A. Mickiewicza 30, 30-059 Krakow, hereinafter referred to as the **AGH University**
- b) The Polish Society of Calorimetry and Thermal Analysis, Warszawa, ul. Kasprzaka 44/52, 01-224 Warszawa, hereinafter referred „**PTKAT**”
- c) Stanisław Staszic Scientific Association, Krakow, ul. Garncarska 5/2, 31-115 Kraków, hereinafter referred to as the „**Association**”

hereinafter referred to collectively „**Controllers**”.

II. Categories of personal data

- a) The Controllers will process the personal data provided in the registration form completed by you, i.e.: first name; last name; academic title/degree; e-mail address; telephone number; institution you represent;
- b) in the case of individuals paying the conference fee from their own bank account, the Controllers will also process billing data - private bank account number;

III. Joint arrangements between the Controllers

In connection with the organization of the 11th School of Thermal Analysis SAT'2026 conference, the Controllers have entered into a personal data joint controllership agreement, in which they have agreed on the scope of their responsibilities regarding the fulfillment of obligations arising from the GDPR. In particular, we have agreed that:

AGH, as the leading institution in the implementation of the obligations imposed by the GDPR, is responsible for:

- a) collecting Participant data;
- b) processing data for informational purposes;
- c) storing and archiving Participant data;
- d) fulfilling the information obligations referred to in Article 13 of the GDPR towards Participants by including it on the registration form;
- e) ensuring Participants exercise their rights under the GDPR. Regardless of this arrangement, Participants may also exercise their rights towards PTKAT and the Association. In such a case, PTKAT and the Association will immediately forward such request to AGH, which will comply with the request of the data subject;
- f) reporting personal data breaches to the supervisory authority, in accordance with Article 33 of the GDPR;
- g) notifying Participants of personal data breaches, in accordance with Article 34 of the GDPR;
- h) acting as a contact point for the supervisory authority.

The Association and PTKAT provide the necessary assistance in the performance of AGH's obligations arising from the provisions of the GDPR, in particular by:

- a) providing AGH with information regarding the processing of Participants' personal data upon request immediately upon receipt of such a request;
- b) reporting to AGH any breach of Participants' personal data protection to AGH;
- c) providing AGH with all information necessary to comply with the obligation to notify Participants of a breach of their data protection;
- d) supporting AGH in fulfilling its obligation to respond to Participants' requests regarding the exercise of their rights set out in Chapter III of the GDPR;
- e) informing AGH of inquiries, requests, or demands from Participants and other individuals, national or EU public administration bodies, including relevant supervisory authorities, and courts, as well as of any audits or inspections by such bodies related to the joint controllership of Participants' personal data.

Furthermore, the Association is responsible for processing the personal data of Participants in connection with providing financial services for the conference.

IV. Purposes and legal basis of processing

- a) Your data will be processed for the purpose of enrolling in the 11th School of Thermal Analysis, communicating with participants in relation with the organisation of the scientific event, documenting its course, and for the purpose of securing data in case of possible claims.
- b) Pursuant to Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR – the processing of your data is necessary for the conclusion and performance of a contract that regulates your participation in a scientific event

- c) Pursuant to Article 6(1)(c) GDPR – the Controller is required to process your data to comply with legal obligations placed on them regarding financial and accounting documentation and reporting

V. Period of personal data storage

Your personal data shall be processed only for the time necessary to achieve the purposes of personal data processing, i.e. for the period resulting from the internal law of the AGH University – Uniform Tangible File Inventory (JRWA), and until your possible withdrawal of consent for data processing in the recruitment process (5 years).

VI. The recipients of your personal data may be:

- a) Entities to which the Controller is obliged to provide data under applicable laws,
- b) Entities providing services to the Controller to the extent necessary for the purposes in connection with which your personal data are processed;
- c) Your personal data may be transferred to state authorities, legal protection authorities (Police, Prosecutor's Office, Court), or local authorities in connection with legal proceedings;
- d) Entity cooperating with the Controllers in organizing the conference 11th serSchool of Thermal Analysis SAT'2026: Ośrodek Konferencyjno – Wypoczynkowy „Hyrny” ul. Piłsudskiego 20, 34-500 Zakopane only in terms of your name and surname.

VII. In connection with the processing of your personal data

- a) You have the right to request from the Controller access to your data, as well as the right to rectify your data, the right to erase your data, the right to restrict the processing of your data, the right to object to the processing thereof in the cases and under the conditions specified in the GDPR;
- b) You have the right to submit a complaint with a supervisory authority – the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection pursuant to Article 77 of the GDPR (...every data subject shall have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, (...) if the data subject considers that the processing of personal data relating to him or her infringes this Regulation);

VIII. The provision of your personal data is voluntary; however, it is a requirement necessary for the Controller to carry out the purposes for which they were collected. Failure to provide your personal data will result in exclusion from participation in the XI School of Thermal Analysis.

IX. Your personal data shall not be subject to automated decision-making processes, including profiling

X. The Controller has the right to take photos and record videos during the events, which they may use for promotional purposes in printed and electronic publications and in social media on the profiles of the Controller's organisational units. Pursuant to Article 81(2)(2) the Act of February 4, 1994 on Copyright and Related Rights (i.e. Journal of Laws 2021, item 1062, as amended), the dissemination of a person's image that is only a detail of a whole, such as a meeting, landscape, or a public event, does not require their permission.
